## **Aging & Disability Resource Center Board of Directors Outstanding Leadership Award**

Presented to a senior volunteer who has excelled in a leadership role in a community nonprofit organization in Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, Okeechobee or Indian River County.



## **CALIDUS Management Volunteer of the Year Award**

Presented to an active senior volunteer involved in making a difference with a nonprofit in Palm Beach, St. Lucie, Martin, Okeechobee or Indian River County.



## **Florida Power & Light Community Service Award**

Presented to a currently active senior volunteer involved with one or more non-profit organization(s) or program(s). This recipient has helped to address a public need or cause that has had a positive impact on the community as a whole.



## **Humana Good Neighbor Award**

Presented to a currently active senior volunteer who has distinguished him/herself through exceptional volunteer efforts and outreach to others in the community.
