Rules:

- Modified IJF rules for both male and female competition.
- Contest area shall be 6x6 meters or 7x7 meters with 4 meter safety area between competition areas and 3 meter outside border.
- For 12 years and under divisions
 - No double drop knee techniques
 - No chokes
 - No arm locks
 - Pre 2003 Medical Rules
- For 16 years and under divisions
 - Players who are choked out are NOT allowed to continue to compete in the tournament
 - No arm locks
 - Pre 2003 Medical Rules
- For Sr. Novice divisions
 - No arm locks
 - Pre 2003 Medical Rules
- For Sr. Brown and Black belt and Masters divisions
 - Full IJF Rules
- Any competitor who suffers a concussion (as determined by the medical staff) and /or who losses consciousness from head impact will not be allowed to continue competing in the tournament that day in any division. If a competitor suffers such an injury, they are strongly advised to obtain a medical release from their personal physician before returning to train and compete in Judo.
- White Judo Gis are mandatory. Blue Judo Gis are optional. **All competitors are required to bring their own white and blue Belts.**
- Double elimination scoring system will be used for 6 or more competitors. Round Robin system will be used for divisions with 5 or less competitors.

Match Time: Juniors, Novice and Masters 3 minutes.
 Senior brown & black belt division's men - 5 minutes, women – 4 minutes.
