

Goals

The goal of the CWA Camp Scholarship program is to provide a variety of scholarship opportunities for the 5-day CWA Youth Summer Camps program. This document outlines all of the options that CWA would offer in 2017. The outreach includes a needs-based (i.e. Household Income), a regional based (thru Newhall Foundation grant) and Veteran's scholarships (thru Veteran Hunt Program).

Needs based - Scholarship application information

Based on annual family household income, signed "affidavit" would be required.

1. Level 1 – \$250 registration fee

Family / household incomes between \$45-65K, \$300 off.

2. Level 2 - \$100 registration fee

Family / household incomes less than \$25-45K, \$450 off.

3. Level 3 - \$0 registration fee

Family / household incomes less than \$25K.

Note: Select the appropriate level on your registration and we will email you an Affidavit for you to sign and return to us. There is a maximum of 1 scholarship per camper for 2017 Summer camp season.

Newhall Foundation scholarship program

Regional outreach to Merced, Firebaugh, Santa Clarita, Santa Margarita and San Francisco. Select this option when you register.

If applied to from this region → \$250 registration fee, (i.e. \$300 off)
