



Frequently Asked Questions

1. What are the hours of camp?

Morning drop-off is between 8:30- 9:00 am and afternoon pick-up is scheduled between 3:30- 4:00 pm daily. *Please make sure to adhere to these hours of operation.*

2. Does camp offer extended hours?

Yes, for a fee of \$15.00/child/day, you can sign your child up for extended camp hours (7:30-5:00).

3. Where is drop-off and pick-up?

Drop-off and pick-up will be in front of our library, on the corner of Olive and Pembroke (one street south of Okeechobee). Please note that we are offering either car pick up or walk up. For car pick up, please come around from Dixie, so as to be on the south side of the street. For walk-up, please park in the Olive parking garage. Upon check-in on the first day of camp, your camper will be assigned to a group – *please familiarize yourself with your child’s group name and counselor’s name to be able to expedite drop-off and pick-up daily.*

4. Can someone other than myself pick-up my child?

Yes – however, you will have to fill out a pick-up form, authorizing any third party to pick your child up on any given day. *Please be advised that any person picking up a child will be ask to provide camp staff with a valid picture ID.*

5. Is lunch provided?

Lunch is not included. Your child must bring in his or her own lunch and snacks each day.

6. What type of experiments will my child perform?

Experiments are designed based on age and depth of knowledge – *please note that no matter what your child’s age is, your student will be visiting some of our teaching laboratories.* Prior to entering a lab, each group will be instructed on proper lab behavior and safety concerns. Each laboratory experiment will be done under the close and constant supervision of a trained scientist. In addition, your child’s counselor will have received specific training and will be very familiar with our curriculum in order to assist our professors and campers during each experiment.

7. What does a typical day at camp look like?

Our schedule will be as follows –
