



### Stacey Konwiser Memorial Save The Tiger 5k - Race Day Schedule 5/20/17

5:45am	Parking lot opens for runners (Enter from Summit Blvd., entry to Dreher Park via Southern Blvd. will be closed)
6:00-7:00am	Race Day packet pick-up & Race Day Registration (\$40 adult, \$25 student under 18), cash or credit card accepted – no personal checks
6:00-7:00am	Bulk water available near registration to fill personal water bottles
7:10-7:25am	<b>OrangeTheory Fitness WPB</b> pre-race warm-up
7:30am	Starting gun
7:30-9:00am	Water is available for runners, at approx. mid-course, at the <b>Run Appeal water station</b>
7:35am	Friends & Family may enter Zoo to await finishers in the Fountain Plaza ( <i>please remain in the Fountain Plaza area until the Zoo opens at 9am</i> )
7:45-8:15am	Up-close animal encounters in the Fountain Plaza
7:45am	First finisher anticipated in the Fountain Plaza
7:45-9:00am	<b>MaxHealth Chiropractic</b> post-race massage in the Fountain Plaza
7:45-9:00am	Post-race fruit (courtesy of <b>Erneston &amp; Sons Produce</b> ), bagels, bottled water for runners in the Fountain Plaza - Save your water bottle and refill at bulk water jugs
8:30am	Approx. start time for awards ceremony, followed by bib number prize drawing courtesy of <b>Fit2Run</b> and <b>Run Appeal</b>
9:00am	Last runner/walker should be across the finish line and the Zoo opens for regular business

### Details

Thank you again for registering to run in the “**Stacey Konwiser Memorial Save The Tiger 5k**” at the **Palm Beach Zoo**.

If you got your packet in advance, you do not need to check in. Please be in the starting line area by 7:00am with your bib on. Pins will be available near the race day tables.

If you’re picking up your packet on race day, please do so between 6:00am and 7:00am at the “check in” table in the parking lot near the Zoo main entry gate.

If you’re purchasing registration on race day, please do so between 6am and 7am at the “race day registration table”.

For the safety of all, please follow the directions of the parking attendants. Parking is available in the main Zoo parking lot until about 6:30am. Additional parking is available just across Summit Blvd. in lots A, B & C of Dreher Park South. Allow 10-15 minutes to walk from outer lots and still arrive at check in by 7:00am. All parking is free.

This run is chip-timed. Your bib has an electronic chip that starts your timer when you pass the starting line. We do ask that walkers and slower runners stage a little farther back in the pack to allow faster runners a clear path at the start. Due to insurance considerations...**no strollers, skateboards, bicycles, wagons allowed on the course, nor pets/animals.**

**Your bib is your Zoo admission for the day.** The tear-off portion at the bottom of your bib is an additional coupon to return to the Zoo on another day to visit again. **Bring your friends and family, too**, your packet includes a coupon for up to 3 half-price admissions to the Zoo for race day. Friends & Family may enter the Zoo at approx. 7:35am after all runners have exited the parking lot and are on the course. The first runners should enter the Fountain Plaza finish line area inside the Zoo at about 7:45am. (Exit and re-entry is permitted on 5/20/17, as long as you have your bib and/or admission receipts.)

The run turns south out of the Zoo parking lot, following a counter clock-wise Dreher Park 5k course, bearing right at the Science Center, to a west side entry into the Zoo. You’ll run past Malayan tigers, wallabies, fennec foxes, New Guinea singing dogs, and more on your way to the finish line at the Interactive Fountain Plaza. A complete course map is available on the event webpage.

### Conservation Opportunities

Runners arriving on **foot, bicycle or car-pool** (4 or more runners in a vehicle) can enter into a drawing for a **\$100 gift card** from Fit2Run at Wellington Green. Please look for the volunteer with the entry forms near the parking lot entrance.

We’ll have a **running shoe recycling bin** near the race-day tables. Those shoes will be turned into playground surfaces.

Remember, on-line registration saves paper! And, please **recycle your packet envelope**.
