

You can help alleviate hunger for 200,000 people in Palm Beach County!

The need: We are looking for 25 volunteers to administer surveys as part of the Hunger Relief Plan to examine Palm Beach County area food pantries' capacity to provide fresh, healthy foods and nutritional resources to the community. This information will then be used to create detailed maps that will highlight areas of need and where current resources are located. We will then use these maps to aid the implementation of the Hunger Relief Plan. There are over 170 food pantries in the county that need to be surveyed.

What you can do to help:

- Attend each location and conduct 8-12 interviews with those receiving food.
- Call pantry administrators and survey them on their pantry's individual needs.

How to get involved: For consistency, you will need to undergo a short training session. Pantries have varying hours but scheduling is flexible based upon your schedule and location in the county.
